Man Charged in Liberty Car Jacking

LIBERTY, Mo. – On May 12, 2019 at about 10:22 a.m., Liberty Police officers responded to 168 Stewart Ct., Texas Roadhouse, to investigate an armed robbery (car jacking) which had just occurred.

A 17-year-old woman reported she had just been robbed of her vehicle and other property by a man armed with a knife while in the parking lot at Texas Roadhouse. No injuries were reported. The victim provided police with a suspect description. Police quickly located the stolen vehicle parked nearby at Lowe's, 1920 N. Stewart Road.

Police, assisted by the Clay County Sheriff's Department, canvassed the area and located a suspect nearby in the parking lot at Liberty RV, 330 N. 291 Hwy. The suspect fled on foot from police, and tried to hide a short distance away. He was placed under arrest and held for further investigation.

On May 13, 2019, Nathaniel T. Bryant, of Liberty, Missouri, was charged by the Clay County Prosecutor's office with the class A felony of robbery 1st degree, and armed criminal action. His bond was set at \$100,000. He is in the custody of the Clay County Jail.
