Suspect Charged in Liberty Kidnapping, Robbery, Sexual Assault

LIBERTY, Mo. – The suspect arrested yesterday for the reported kidnapping, robbery and sexual assault at the Dr. Spotless Car Wash is identified as Terry E. Campbell, 35 years old, of Liberty, MO.

Campbell has been charged in Clay County with the felonies of Kidnapping 1st Degree, Robbery 1st Degree, Sexual Abuse 1st Degree, Tampering With Motor Vehicle 1st Degree, and two counts of Armed Criminal Action. He remains in custody at the Clay County Jail and his bond was set at \$150,000. Mr. Campbell is presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.

The charges stem from crimes reported Wednesday, June 17 at the Dr. Spotless Car Wash in the 1100 block of Missouri Court, in Liberty, MO. A 61 year old Liberty woman reported to Liberty Police that she was kidnapped and taken away, robbed and sexually assaulted, and then returned to the car wash by the suspect. She reported the crimes immediately afterward and received medical attention.

Campbell was arrested yesterday, June 18, after Liberty police officers spotted the suspect vehicle at about noon, occupied in the Liberty Commons parking lot. The suspect refused to yield to police, and after a dangerous vehicle and foot pursuit, he was taken into custody by police in Kansas City near I-435 & N. Mersington. Assistance was provided by the Kansas City, Missouri Police Department, the Clay County Sheriff's Department and the Missouri State Highway Patrol.
