Drowning Victim Recovered at Liberty's Sports Complex

LIBERTY, Mo. — Liberty Police are investigating the death of a 19-year-old Liberty woman who reportedly jumped into the retention pond and drowned at Capitol Federal Sports Complex in Liberty, MO.

Dispatchers received a 911 call on Monday, August 24 at about 2:51 p.m. from a woman who reported she was driving by the sports complex with her cousin, Dashiza Jordan, when Jordan began to panic. The caller pulled over and Jordan reportedly got out of the car, jumped into the pond and did not come out of the water.

Liberty Police and Fire Departments responded to the scene. They checked the area and could not locate the woman. Additional resources from the Kansas City Fire Department and Missouri State Highway Patrol were called to the scene to perform water search and recovery efforts.

Search and recovery efforts were suspended temporarily overnight on Monday. This morning, the Missouri State Highway Patrol recovered a body believed to be the missing woman. The case remains under investigation and we request that the privacy of the family be respected.
