DOG PARK HOURS: 6 a.m. - 10 p.m.

RULES

- Use the Dog Park at your own risk.
- Owners, harborers and trustees or those having charge, custody or control of an animal are legally responsible for its behavior and any injuries it may cause.
- Dog waste must be cleaned up **IMMEDIATELY** by their owners and placed in a sealed plastic bag and properly disposed of.
- Dogs must wear current Rabies Tag and City License issued by Veterinarian or City.
- Dogs must be leashed when entering and exiting the Dog Park.
- Dog owners must remain in the park, carry a leash, maintain visual contact and dogs should be under voice control.
- Minors are required to be accompanied by a parent or guardian. We do not recommend young children or infants be in the Dog Park.

PROHIBITED

- Human & Dog food/treats
- Glass Containers
- Puppies (under 4 months old) or lacking full vaccination series
- Dogs in heat
- Aggressive Dogs
- Sick Dogs
- Choke, prong, pinch, spike, training or other correction collars

Failure to abide by the park rules may result in loss of privileges and/or owners may be ticketed for city ordinance violations.
